During Your Stay

Warburton's forests, waterways, mountains and walking trails are some of the region's greatest treasures. This short guide sets out simple ways you can help us protect them - during your stay with us, and while you are out exploring the Yarra Valley.

In your room and around the hotel

- ☐ **Reduce energy use during your stay**
Switch off lights, heating and cooling when you head out for the day.
 - ☐ **Conserve water through our linen reuse program**
Hang towels you are happy to reuse; leave them in the bath only if you would like them replaced.
 - ☐ **Recycle and reduce waste**
Use the recycling streams provided for cardboard, paper and eligible cans. Eligible cans are processed through Victoria's Container Deposit Scheme, with funds donated to Koha Community Café.
 - ☐ **Respect our gardens and natural surroundings**
Our grounds are planted with native, low-water and locally endemic species that support local birds and insects.
 - ☐ **Protect local wildlife**
Please do not feed native animals or birds, and keep food secured indoors.
 - ☐ **Be considerate of other guests and the community**
We are a heritage building in a residential town - sound carries further than you might expect.
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Refillable amenities

We have replaced single-use bathroom amenities with larger refillable dispensers, stocked with Warbotanical natural hair and body care - locally made, using natural ingredients including organic hemp, and free from SLS.

When you are out exploring

- Stay on marked walking tracks and trails.
- Respect native plants and wildlife.
- Take rubbish with you, or use the recycling and waste facilities provided.
- Leave natural areas exactly as you found them.
- Be considerate of other visitors and the local community.
